DEPARTMENT OF NAVY SELECTS AMERICAN SECURITY PROGRAMS TO PROVIDE SECURITY

Dulles, VA – April 12, 2007 – American Security Programs has been awarded a major contract with the United States Navy. The new contract requires American Security Programs to provide elite security teams for nine military bases across the southeastern region of the country.

The new contract is one of the largest of the federal security sector.
